Westfield State College invites applications and nominations for President of the College.

The College: Westfield State College, located in an historic, aesthetically inspiring and economically expanding area of western Massachusetts, is an undergraduate and master's degree granting, comprehensive public institution - one of nine Massachusetts state colleges. Building on a tradition of excellence and innovation and emphasizing effective teaching, student engagement and experiential learning and service, the College offers a dynamic and diverse learning community in which students are prepared for leadership in society.

The College's profile includes: total enrollment approximating 5,500; 22 major undergraduate programs of study; graduate programs in criminal justice, education, english, psychology, and public administration; 184 full-time faculty; 324 full-time staff; 31,000 alumni; NCAA Division III athletics; 256 acre campus. Among the College's distinctive characteristics are: founding by Horace Mann; the first public co-educational school for teacher education in the United States; highest six year graduation rate and residential student percentage among Massachusetts state colleges.
