To The Westfield State Community:

On Sunday, August 30, Westfield State College will open its doors to welcome approximately 5,000 students back to campus for the beginning of the 2009-2010 academic school year. As we do so, you should know we are monitoring reports of cases of H1N1 influenza around the country.

There have been no confirmed cases of H1N1 at Westfield State but public health officials expect a resurgence of H1N1 this fall and we are actively taking steps to prepare for this situation.
